General Terms & Conditions:

1. Catering service for approx 650 persons. Number of persons can be increased or decreased up to 10 percent. All interested firms are requested to submit quotation per person per day **before 20.12.2024**.

3. The menu for daily meals is enclosed at Annexure -3.

Meals Timings:

4. The morning tea/coffee (150 ml) (6:00AM to 6:30 AM) will be served at respective place of stay i.e. hostel.

5. The breakfast (8:00 AM to 9:00 AM) and Dinner (8:00 PM to 9:00 PM) will be served at school mess.

6. Lunch will be served at Exhibition venue, with Buffet System.

7. The Refreshment (10:30 AM to 11:00 AM), Lunch (1:00 PM to 2:00 PM) and Evening Tea (5:00 PM to 6:00 PM) will be served at the venue of the exhibition. The space will be provided at the venue of the exhibition, the vendor will have to do all necessary arrangement on their own at the venue of the exhibition like crockery, cutlery, plates, dustbins etc.
